Articles of Incorporation of a Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation

To form a **nonprofit public benefit corporation** in California, you can fill out this form or prepare your own document, and submit for filing along with:

- A **\$30** filing fee.
- A separate, non-refundable **\$15** service fee also must be included, if you **drop off** the completed form or document.

Important! California nonprofit corporations are **not** automatically exempt from paying California franchise tax or income tax each year. **A separate application is required in order to obtain tax exempt status.** For more information, go to https://www.ftb.ca.gov/businesses/exempt_organizations or call the California Franchise Tax Board at (916) 845-4171.



Articles of Incorporation

ONE: The name of this corporation is UMASDA, Inc..

TWO: This corporation is a nonprofit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for charitable purposes. The specific purposes for which this corporation is organized are Research, development, and instruction of Self Defense methods.

THREE: The name and address in the State of California of this corporation's initial agent for service of process is Steve Zalazowski, [REDACTED]

FOUR: (a) The initial street address of the corporation is: 339 Maple St Unit C, Salinas, CA 93901.

(b) The initial mailing address of the corporation, if different from the initial street address, is: UMASDA Inc., Attn: Steve Zalazowski – President, [REDACTED]


FIVE: (a) This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for educational purposes meeting the requirements of Section 214 of the California Revenue and Taxation Code, and within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

(b) Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (1) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or (2) by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code.

(c) No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign (including the publishing or distribution of statements) on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

SIX: The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to educational purposes meeting the requirements of Section 214 of the California Revenue and Taxation Code, and no part of the net income or assets of the organization shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer, or member thereof or to the benefit of any private person.

On the dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment of, or provision for payment of, all debts and liabilities of this corporation, shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation, or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for educational or amateur sports competition and which has established its tax-exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.


